

Calhoun County HarvestFest & Alpaca Showcase 2011
Calhoun County Fairgrounds, Marshall, Michigan . October 8, 2011
10 AM to 5 PM

1. Registration. Entries must be received by October 1, 2011.
2. No registrations will be accepted after this date.
3. Medical. All alpacas are required to be in good health with no obvious physical ailments.
4. This showcase is not an AOBA certified show so AOBA Show Division membership is not required. ARI registration is not required. Fiber animals welcome.
5. There will be an obstacle course competition in the arena on Saturday. There is no charge for participation in the obstacle course but registration is required.
6. Stalls.
 - a. A. 10x 10 stalls will be provided by Calhoun County. The barn floor is concrete so stall mats are recommended.
 - b. Each farm will be allowed a maximum of three (3) stalls.
 - c. A maximum of three (3) animals per stall. Six (6) animals per farm.
 - d. There are three (3) slightly larger areas available for farm stores. There will be no animal pens in these areas. These will be awarded upon request on a first come . first served based. Charges for these areas will be the same as three (3) stalls.
 - e. Stalls will be pre-assigned based on when registration is received.
7. Check-in. Friday October, 7, 2011 from 3 PM to 7 PM at the Calhoun County Fairgrounds Sheep Barn. There will be NO check-in Saturday morning.
8. Costs.
 - a. Stalls . MI-ALPACA Members - \$35 per stall
Non Members - \$40 per stall
 - b. There is no charge for alpacas brought to the showcase.
 - c. Camping - \$20 per night. Private bathroom and shower facilities are included.
9. Electricity. There are outlets available throughout the building. You must supply your own extension cord(s).
10. Waste disposal. Dumpsters will be provided for manure and garbage. Each farm is responsible for cleaning their stalls at the end of the show.
